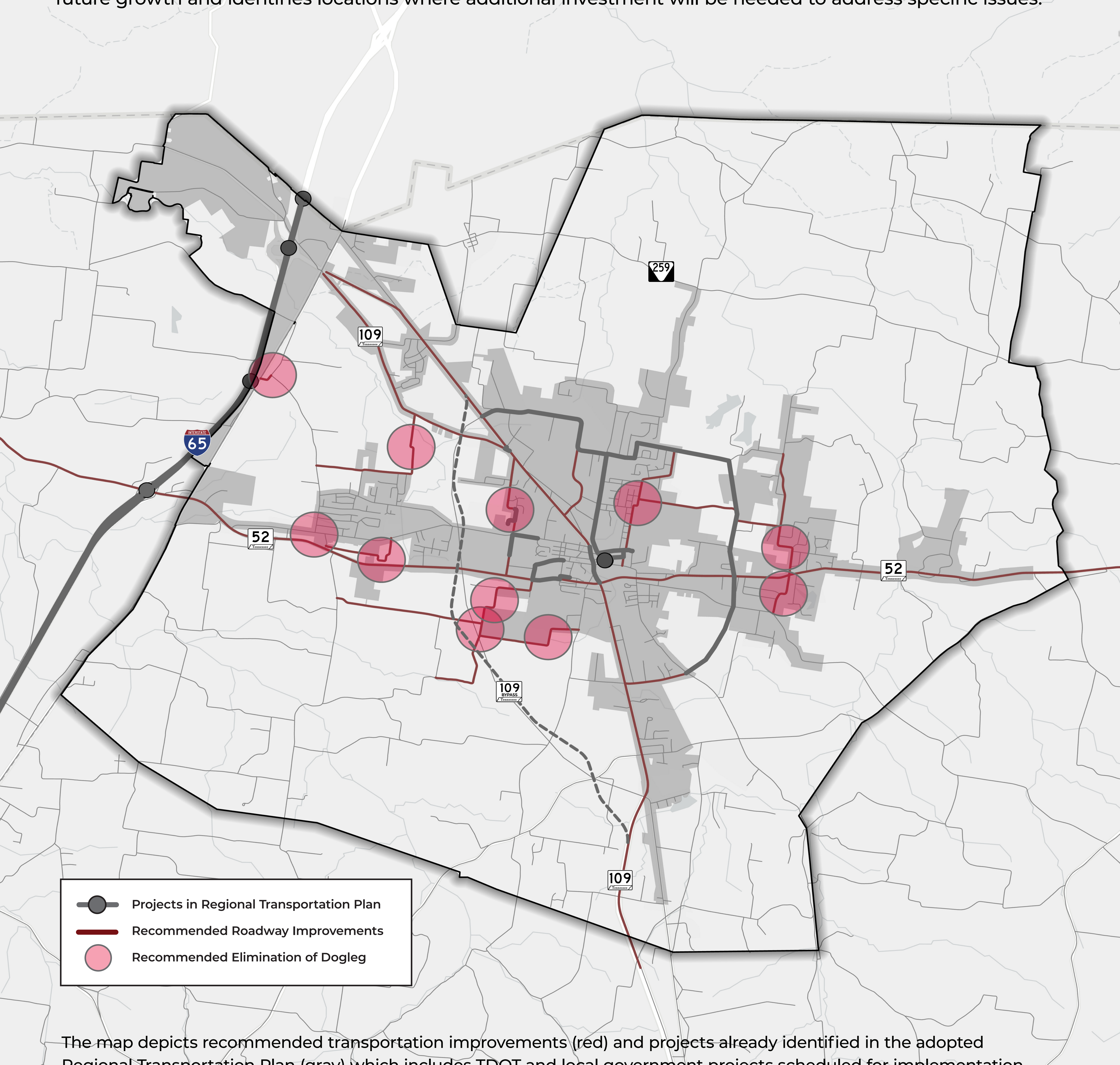


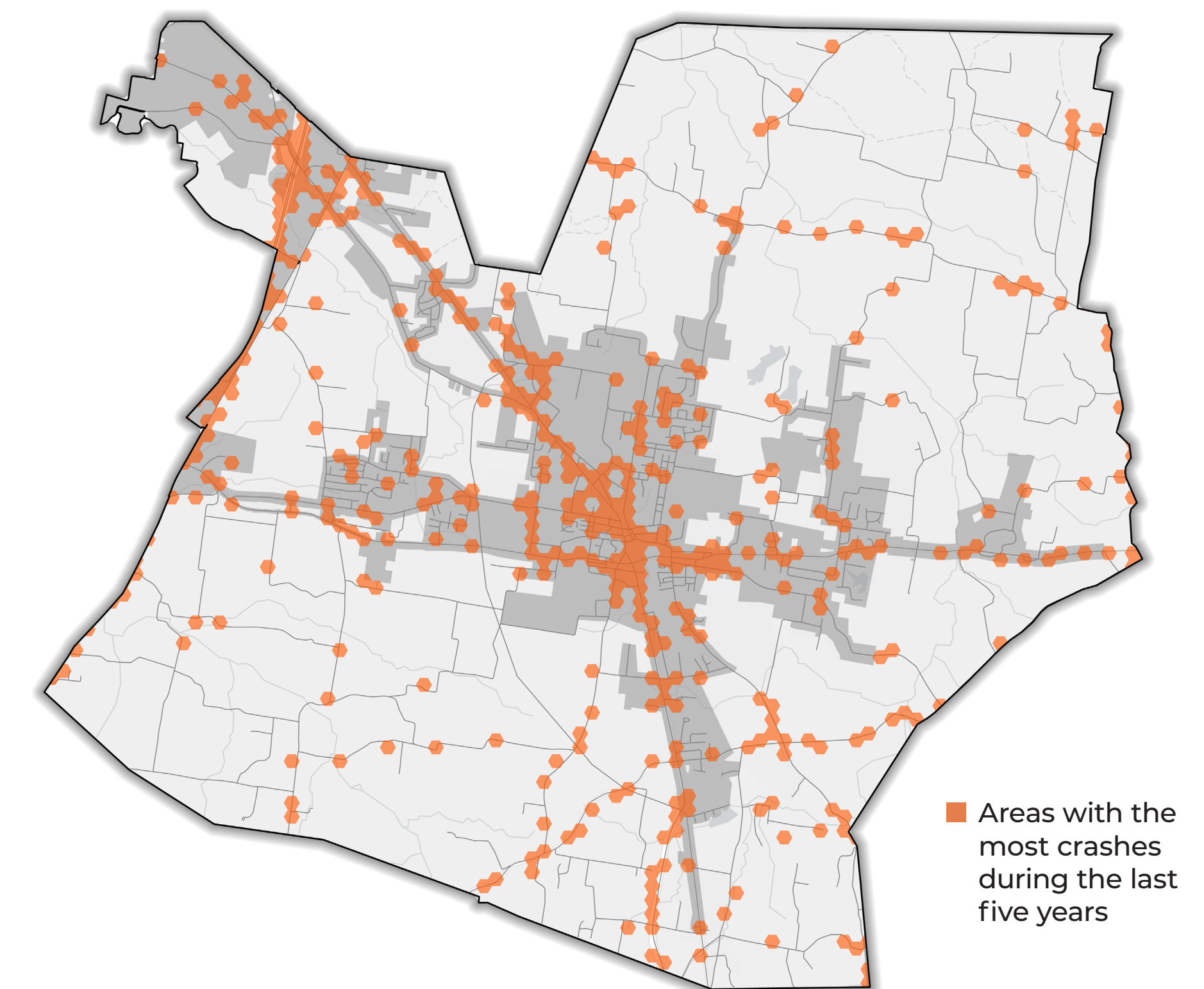
TRANSPORTATION

Preserving Portland took into consideration planned transportation improvements to help the city prepare for future growth and identifies locations where additional investment will be needed to address specific issues.



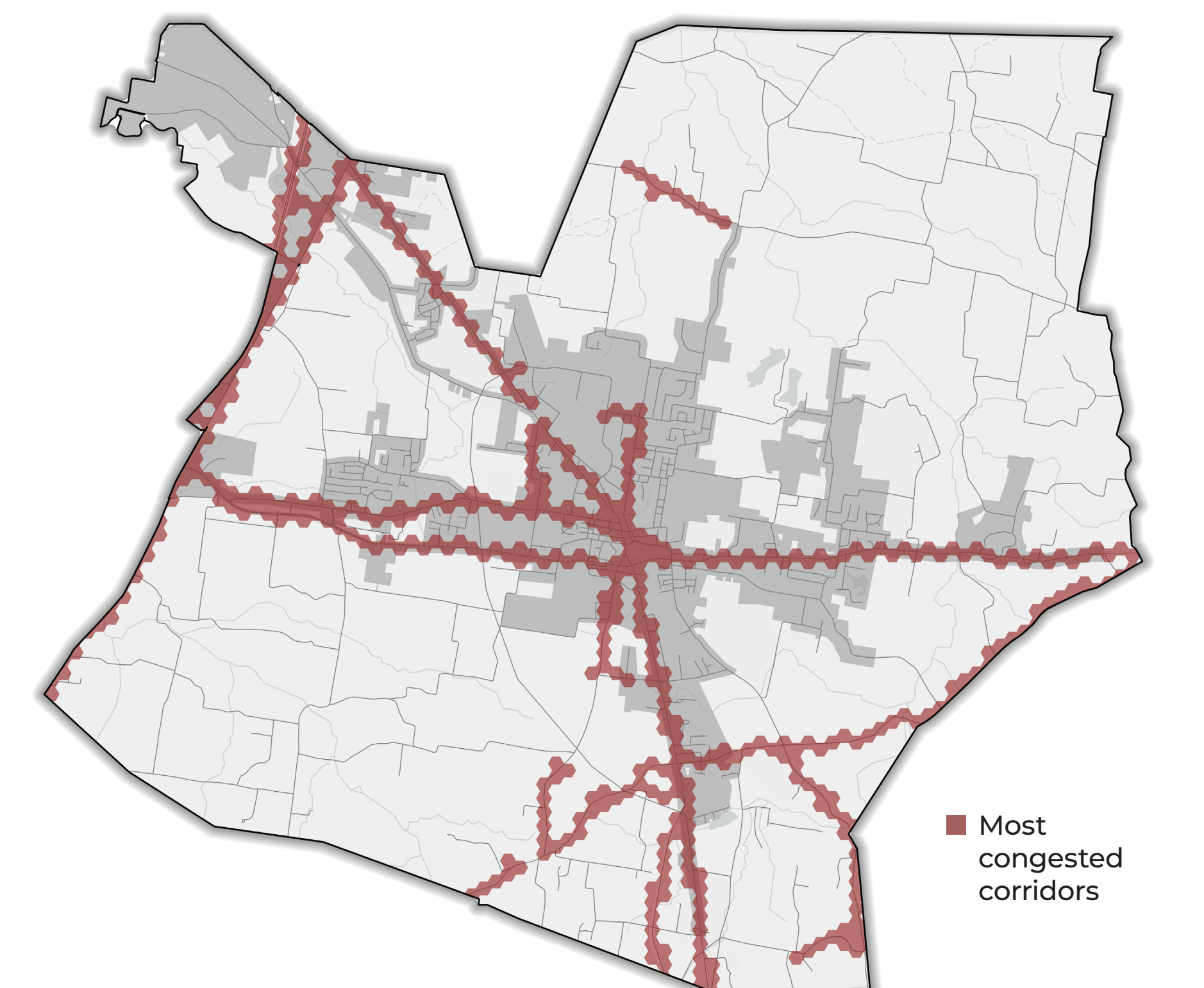

TRANSPORTATION CHALLENGES



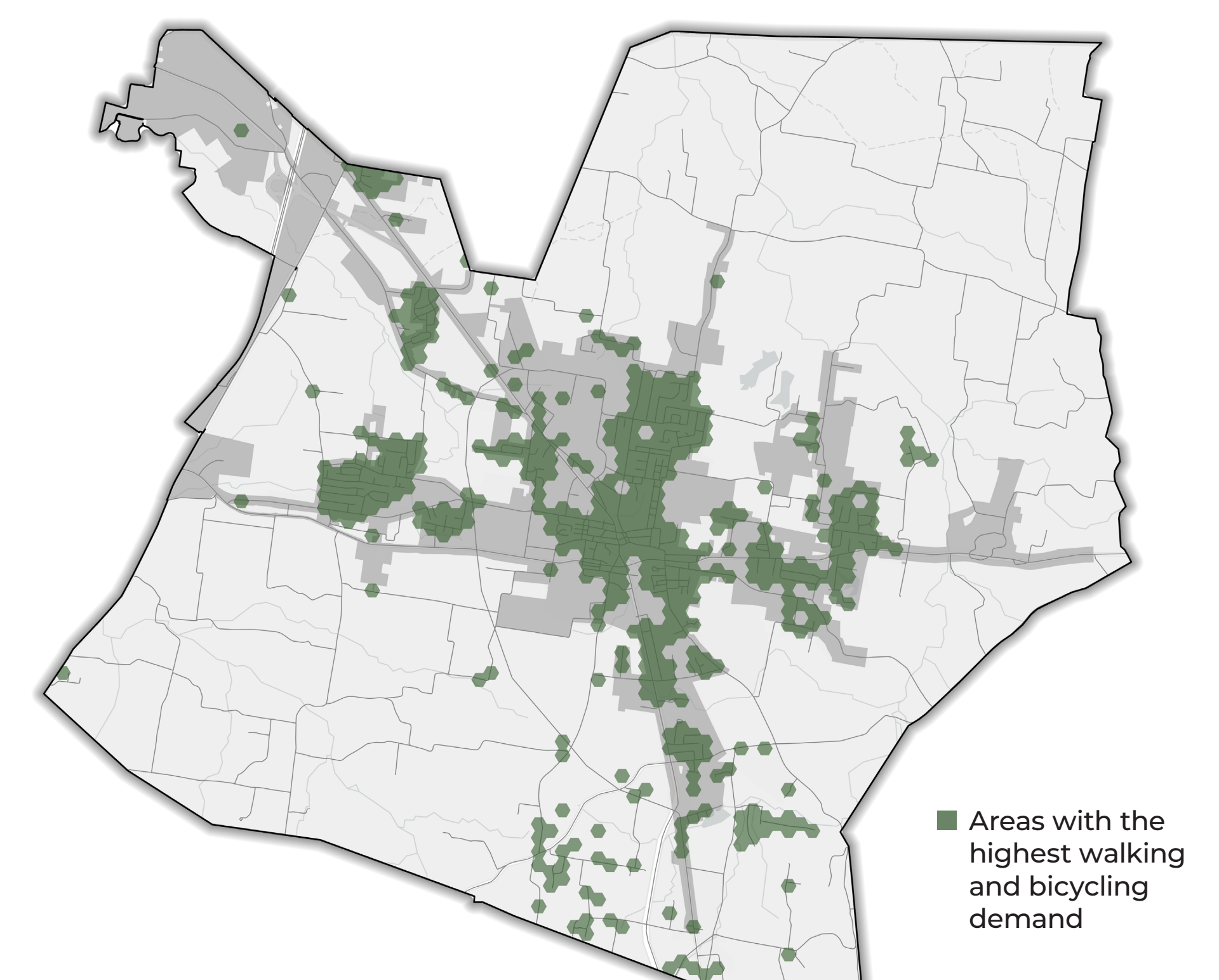
ROADWAY SAFETY CONCERNS
