
# **Regional Trend**

## Projected Growth by 2045

#### **REGIONAL PLANNING AREA**

The seven-county Nashville metropolitan planning area\* is expected to grow from 1.8 million people in 2020 to more than **2.7 million people by 2045.** 

Located within two growing counties, the City of Portland has



experienced a 56 percent population growth since 2000 and is the third fastest-growing municipality in Sumner County.
